

TARRAGON HERBS



Hardy perennial. Strongly aromatic grey-green leaves used for flavouring TSW: 0.2 g;Seed amount: Pots 5g/1000 pots; Direct seeding 30-50g/100 M² Use: It enhances fish, pork, beef, poultry, game, potatoes, tomatoes, carrots, and most mainstream vegetables. It also goes well with lemons and oranges.

Length Plant IE :	45 - 60 cm
Sowing period :	March-April in 30 cm rows
Seeds Per 10 Gr IE :	60,000-70,000

Cultivation: Transplant to permanent site July Spacing 35 x 45 cm apart

Tarragon prefers sandy, well-drained loamy soil and will do well in full sun or partial shade It can

be divided and potted for the winter, but may resist transplanting As an indoor plant it requires good light.
